About the instructors

Andrew Sato is chief instructor of the AAA/AAI and dojo cho of Tenshinkan Dojo the headquarters dojo of the AAA. His practice and study of Aikido had been under Toyoda Shihan exclusively. Having started practicing Aikido in the winter of 1977, Sato Sensei is at Rokudan rank and was appointed Shihandai by Toyoda Shihan. He has served on the board of directors of the Ki Aikido Society, Midwest region; as President of the Chicago-area Hakamakai group, and as Chair of the Committee Celebrating the 25th Anniversary of Toyoda Shihan's Aikido in America.

James M. Nakayama is the founder and Chief Instructor of Chushinkan Dojo, Buena Park, California. His martial arts background extends back over 45 years, starting first with judo, then aikido in 1973 and later iaido. Nakayama Sensei is Director of the AAA's Western Region. He is a member of the National Teaching Committee and has instructed within the AAA and for the AAI in Europe for many years. Nakayama Sensei was appointed Shihandai and holds the rank of godan in aikido and yondan in iaido.
